Section 4. MISCELLANEOUS, D. of the Rules and Regulations of the Code of Conduct Review Board is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 4. MISCELLANEOUS

D. Quorum and Telephonic Attendance by Board Members at Non Quasi-Judicial Meetings

The Board may not act on any manner without a quorum of the Board being present. Board members may participate in non-quasi-judicial meetings by means of a conference telephone or other similar communications equipment, with the Chair's approval twenty-four (24) hours prior to the scheduled meeting, when it is otherwise difficult or impossible for the Board member to attend the meeting in person. The member choosing to participate in such a way shall be audible to all other members of the Board and the public, in addition to the requirements of the Open Meetings Act, NMSA (1978), § 10-15-1, et seq. being met.

This Amendment shall be effective upon filing with the Bernalillo County Clerk.
