PRELIMINARY ODER

THIS MATTER came before the Bernalillo County Code of Conduct Review Board (BCCCRB) on Thursday, February 8, 2018. After careful review of Sworn Complaint 2018-SC001 filed on January 9, 2018, and hearing both parties, W. Dennis Maez, Complainant, and Commissioner Wayne Johnson, Respondent's arguments, the BCCCRB FINDS as follows:

The Bernalillo County Code of Conduct Review Board unanimously voted and determined that the Sworn Complaint states a facial claim sufficient to warrant an Evidentiary Hearing be held on March 22, 2018, at 1:00p.m., based on the Bernalillo County Code of Conduct, Sec. 2-131. (1)(3).

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. The parties shall submit any Briefs, which shall contain a written statement of the issues to be addressed, a list of witnesses and a summary of the witness' testimony, and copies of any written evidence including proposed exhibits, to be introduced to the Compliance Office no later than 5:00 p.m. on March 9, 2018.
2. Parties objecting to authenticity of proposed exhibits must make an objection in writing to the Compliance Office at least three (3) days prior to the scheduled Hearing and shall provide a copy of the objection to opposing parties simultaneously. A party's failure to make a timely objection to the authenticity of opposing party's exhibits shall result in the admission of those exhibits.

3. Any party requiring a subpoena for a witness to appear should make such a request through the Compliance Office no later than 5:00p.m., March 9, 2018 and the Chair of the Board shall issue such subpoenas.
4. Any Pre-Hearing Motions that require the Board's consideration shall be filed with the Compliance Office no later than 5:00p.m., on March 9, 2018.
5. A full Evidentiary Hearing shall be held on March 22, 2018, at 1:00p.m. The time and location of the Hearing shall be provided to both parties in a Notice of Hearing, which shall be delivered to both parties no later than ten (10) days prior to the hearing date.
6. The time limits for presentations during the Evidentiary Hearing are set forth in the Board's Rules and Regulations.
