

Importance of the Interview



How important is the interview? In a nutshell, the interview is everything. It's where the employer makes a decision. Studies say interviewers often make up their minds within the first 15 minutes of the meeting.



Be on time or early-allow for traffic and parking time.

Check your appearance prior to entering the building/interview room- arrive early enough to go to the bathroom and check your appearance.

Be prepared if the interviewer is late- If the interviewer is late by 15 minutes, approach the office manager or receptionist and politely ask when the interviewer will be free.

Be particular about your dress and appearance— How you dress and groom yourself can create a big first impression.

Give a firm handshake and maintain good eye contact— If the employer offers his or her hand, give a firm (but not too firm) handshake and smile).

Act interested and alert- When you are sitting, lean slightly forward in your chair, and keep your head up, look directly at the interviewer.

Pay attention to your voice- if you are naturally soft-spoken, work on speaking louder.
