**ADMINISTRATIVE RESOLUTION NO. 2018-55**

1 **A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE SIX-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN**  
2 **(CIP) 2018-2024.**

4 **WHEREAS**, the County of Bernalillo develops a six-year plan for capital improvements,  
5 of several project types, on a biennial basis; and

6 **WHEREAS**, development of the 2018-2024 CIP informed and solicited input from  
7 neighborhood residents and organizations in each of the five County Commission districts  
8 through neighborhood meetings, online information, and project requests; and

9 **WHEREAS**, development of the 2018-2024 CIP involved County departments in an  
10 inventory and prioritization of capital requests; and

11 **WHEREAS**, the 2018-2024 CIP involved a Capital Improvement Planning Committee in  
12 reviewing priorities, technical evaluation ranking of projects of the same type, and  
13 recommending a package of projects to the County Commission, and

14 **WHEREAS**, the 2018-2024 CIP is representative of the County's top capital project  
15 priorities for 2018 and preliminary proposes amounts by county division and future bond  
16 questions for the 2020 and 2022 cycles which will come back to the Commission for approval;  
17 and

18 **WHEREAS**, the 2018-2024 CIP is fiscally constrained at \$38,700,000 in the 2018 cycle  
19 and \$38.5 million in the 2020 and 2022 cycles;

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




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1           **NOW, THEREFORE**, be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners, the
