Fireworks Restrictions in Effect

The ban remains in force through July 12, 2018.

Bernalillo County has banned the sale and use of aerial devices to include aerial shell kit-reloadable tubes, aerial missile-type rockets, helicopters, aerial spinners, stick-type rockets, and roman candles. Also banned are ground audible devices that include firecrackers and chasers within the unincorporated areas of Bernalillo County, outside the city limits of Albuquerque.

All fireworks are banned in wildland areas of the county within the unincorporated areas of Bernalillo County:

- East of Louisiana Boulevard to the west face of the Sandia Mountains
- From San Antonio north to the Pueblo of Sandia
- All the East Mountain area, north, south and east to the county line
- Portions of the unincorporated areas to include the Rio Grande bosque and wildland areas extending 1,000 feet from the outer edge of the bosque.

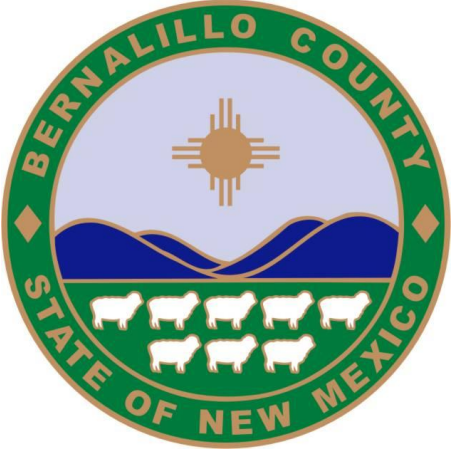

Fourth of July UBER Codes for Rides

BernaCo and the New Mexico Department of Transportation are joining with Uber and Cumulus Media to offer patrons 400 free or low-cost Uber rides during the Fourth of July holiday. Patrons need to download the Uber app to their phones and enter the code **ABQUSA18**. Rides will be available from Tuesday, July 3 beginning at noon through Thursday, July 5 ending at 4 a.m. By using the code, riders will receive a credit of up to \$10. The maximum amount of trips available is 400. First come, first served. The credit can only be used for rides, not Uber Eats, and the discount does not cover tip.

Sunport Boulevard and Woodward Road Improvements PUBLIC HEARING Thursday, July 19 Open house at 6 p.m., Presentation at 6:30 p.m. Mountain View Community Center, 201 Prosperity Ave. SE

Bernalillo County Public Works Division in cooperation with the NMDOT and the Federal Highway Administration have completed an environmental assessment (EA) for the proposed extension of Sunport Boulevard between I-25 and Broadway Boulevard, and associated improvements to Woodward Road between 2nd Street and Broadway Boulevard. The purpose of this project is to improve roadway connectivity, and address other transportation and access needs in this area. The EA evaluates the No Build and the Build Alternative and provides detailed information about the purpose and need for the project, the major design features, and the impacts to the human and natural environments and to cultural resources. The public hearing will provide a summary of the EA and the major findings, and provide an opportunity for the public to comment on the EA and the proposed action.
