1. Outline: misdemeanor, 3rd or 4th felony highest charge - police report to PD < 4 days of arrest; follow up reports 15 days; PD ready for trial < 21 days thereafter; resolution/trial 40 days; one extension (< 21 days “extraordinary cause”). Highest charge 2nd degree felony – similar but longer times. Highest charge 1st degree felony – constitutional speedy trial.
