“Since implementation of the PSA-Court, and as compared to the four years prior to July 1, 2013, the new criminal activity rate has dropped significantly. The average arrest rate for released defendants has declined from 10% to 8.5%. This represents a **15% reduction in pretrial crime**.<sup>1</sup> Moreover, while more defendants are now being released, Kentucky has not seen any increase in the rate at which defendants miss court. In short, Kentucky is now detaining more high-risk and potentially violent defendants, while more low-risk defendants are being released. And crime is down. In addition to the positive impacts on crime and pretrial incarceration, Pretrial Services has reported that the tool has allowed a more effective deployment of resources. In large part, this is because the PSA-Court can be completed without conducting a defendant interview.”
